TERMS & CONDITIONS:

By returning this form and making payment for YOUR craft stall YOU as Stall Holder accept and will commit to meeting and adhering to the following conditions and expectations:

The Hall committee will not be held responsible nor accept any liability for any form of damage or injury resulting from YOUR stall, business activity and/or products sold by YOU. YOU must have sufficient and valid Public Liability Insurance which covers your business and your business activity for the full day and date of the Craft Fair. A copy of this must be provided.

YOU will be expected to ensure that your stall/stand, business activities and products sold are all safe and comply with all current relevant legislation. YOU must pay due attention to the health and safety of all individuals present at the event and you must conduct your own Risk assessment.

YOUR Trading/Selling should only be that as outlined in "Description of the Stall" above and can only take place from the allocated stand area. YOU are not permitted to sub-let, transfer or share a Stand Space WITHOUT prior agreement. YOU must not trade or sell goods which may cause harm or offence. YOU will be expected to sell products only to individuals that are of an age that is appropriate for the product.

The event opens at 10 and all stall holders will be expected to have their stalls ready for trading by 10:00. Unless asked to do so no Stall holder will close or pack away their stand until the close of the event which will be 2:00pm. The stand space must be left as found.

YOU are expected to provide your table unless you have requested one. There is electricity supplied by the hall and generators will not be permitted unless prior permission is obtained. If you particularly need to be near a power socket please request this in your application. There is no power available externally.

Exhibitors must obey any and all instructions from the Hall Management Committee whilst on the premises and the Hall Management Committee reserve the right to stop a stall holder from trading.

The Hall Management Committee do not accept any responsibility for the security of YOUR stall and will not be responsible for any loss of profits, consequential loss or any loss whatsoever arising by reason of YOUR presence / participation at the Fete.

We would ask that YOUR stall/stand is made accessible and enjoyable to all – both able-bodied and not.

If you are unwell etc on the day and can't attend please do let us know as early as possible.

The stall fee is non-refundable unless the Hall Management Committee takes the decision to cancel the event. Please contact the Hall Management Committee for any further clarification.

For this fundraiser event many participants are donating to the fundraising cause. You are not expected to do this but if you wish to contribute to the raffle prizes, or offer any fundraising items on your stall this would be very appreciated.
